Call for Films Announcement

The tenth annual Alaska Forum on the Environment, to be held February 11-15, 2008, will host our Film Festival as part of the weeklong event. We are inviting interested agencies, organizations, as well as individual participants to submit films to be shown at the Film Festival.

Films should be current, applicable to the Alaska Forum on the Environment (AFE) and not more than 30 minutes in length. Suggested topics include: invasive species, climate change, emergency response, environmental regulations, fish and wildlife populations, rural issues, energy resources and conservation, pollution prevention, and contaminants.

The mission of the Forum is to have all Alaskans working together to promote a clean, healthy environment through communication and education. Films must be submitted on CD or DVD in North America format. Agencies or organizations submitting a film must provide a representative or a written introduction to the film that can be read prior to its presentation. Submissions should be high quality productions worthy of placement in the Film Festival. All entries must be pre-screened for eligibility. Each work is judged solely on its own merits for originality, quality, content and adherence to conference themes.

Receipt Acknowledgement

To receive acknowledgement of receipt of your entry, you must enclose a stamped self-addressed envelope or postcard with your submission.

Notification

Films selected for screening will be notified no later than December 15, 2007.
